

Jeremiah 30:20 – 31:3 + 9

The regathering of the exiles will be accompanied by the outpouring of wrath on the nations, pictured as a whirlwind, or the “threshing wind” that separates wheat from chaff and is pictured at Pentecost as the sound of a “mighty, rushing wind.”

Jeremiah 30:23 - “Behold, the whirlwind of the LORD goeth forth with fury, a continuing whirlwind: it shall fall with pain upon the head of the wicked.”

The same word for building the Tower - “banah”- is used of building Israel/the Bride:

Jeremiah 31:4 - “Again I will build thee, and thou shalt be built, O virgin of Israel”

Edification - the “building up” of the Body of Christ - is the contrast to the prideful building up of a Tower to defy heaven.
